11 County, was a faithful witness for Jesus; and

12 WHEREAS, Mick departed these earthly bounds on August 5, 2022, and now joins
13 his Lord and Savior in his Heavenly, eternal home; and

14 WHEREAS, Mick is survived by his parents; siblings, Andy Crawford (Angie),
15 Ginger Simmons (James), Stevie Combs, Bailey Crawford (Amy), Kyle Crawford, Austin
16 Combs (Bryan), and Rachel Crawford (Michael); maternal grandfather, Raymond Griffie
17 (Ann); and a host of other family members, friends, and loved ones; and
