Amend printed copy of **SB 129/SCS 1**

On page 1 deleting lines 5 through 20 and inserting the following:

"(1) As used in this section:

(a) "Automated license plate reader" or "ALPR" means a system of one (1) or more mobile or fixed high-speed cameras combined with computer algorithms to convert images of license plates into data that is readable by a computer system; and

(b) "Entity" means any law enforcement agency, unit of local government, school or university, homeowner's association, company, or individual that deploys and maintains ALPRs.

(2) An ALPR may only be deployed and maintained by:

(a) An entity for the sole purpose of protecting public safety, conducting criminal investigations, or ensuring compliance with local, state, or federal law; or

(b) The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for the sole purpose of toll collection activities on highways and bridges.

(3) License plate data captured by an ALPR shall not be retained for more than ninety (90) days, except when the data is captured by:

(a) An entity and is being used as evidence in a criminal prosecution or administrative investigation; or

(b) The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet and is being used for toll collection activities
