On page 1, lines 5 through 24, delete in its entirety and insert in lieu thereof:

- "(1) For the purposes of this section, "governmental body" has the same meaning as in KRS 45A.030.
- (2) All governmental bodies and the Administrative Office of the Courts shall provide sufficient staffing on-site to ensure that phone calls from the public are answered promptly. All governmental bodies shall allow for a caller to speak to a live person during regular business hours, except during state holidays pursuant to KRS 18A.190. A governmental body or the Administrative Office of the Courts may determine staffing levels based on phone call volume during the preceding two (2) fiscal years.
- (3) If the Governor declares an emergency pursuant to KRS Chapter 39A, governmental bodies or the Administrative Office of the Courts may reduce on-site staffing, as appropriate, due to the declared emergency, but shall not exceed thirty (30) days unless approved by the General Assembly pursuant to 39A.090."
