5		each designate a member from his or her respective chamber to serve as co-chair.
6	<u>(4)</u>	Any vacancy that may occur in the membership of the subcommittee shall be
7		filled by the same appointing authority who made the original appointment.
8	<u>(5)</u>	A majority of the membership of the subcommittee shall constitute a quorum, and
9		all actions of the subcommittee shall be by a vote of a majority of its membership.
10	<u>(6)</u>	Any professional, clerical, or other employees required by the subcommittee shall
11		be provided in accordance with the provisions of KRS 7.090(4) and (5).
