2	Be it enac	ted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	⇒SI	ECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 367 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS	FOLLOWS:
5	<u>(1) As u</u>	sed in this section, ''air ambulance membership agreement'':
6	<u>(a)</u>	Means an agreement in exchange for consideration to pay for, indemnify,
7		or provide an amount or benefit to a person for the cost of air ambulance
8		services; and
9	<u>(b)</u>	Does not include a health insurance plan or policy regulated under KRS
10		<u>Chapter 304.</u>
11	<u>(2) (a)</u>	It shall be unlawful for any individuals or entity to sell, offer for sale, or
12		provide an air ambulance membership agreement to an individual who is
13		enrolled in the state's medical assistance program established in KRS
14		<u>Chapter 205.</u>
15	<u>(b)</u>	If an individual who has purchased or who has otherwise been provided
16		with an air ambulance membership agreement subsequently enrolls in the
17		state's medical assistance program during the duration of the membership
18		agreement, the individual shall be entitled to a pro-rated refund of any
19		consideration paid.
20	<u>(3) (a)</u>	All air ambulance membership agreement websites, brochures, and
21		marketing material shall include the following disclosure in at least
22		eighteen (18) point Times New Roman font:
23		"Kentucky Medicaid, the state's medical assistance program, covers air
24		ambulance transport services and requires no out-of-pocket expense by the
25		enrollee. Therefore, an enrollee in the state's medical assistance program
26		does not need an air ambulance membership agreement. It is unlawful for
27		[seller] to sell an air ambulance membership agreement to an enrollee in

1	the state's medical assistance program."
2	(b) All air ambulance membership agreement applications shall include the
3	<u>following disclosure in at least eighteen (18) point Times New Roman font:</u>
4	"Kentucky Medicaid, the state's medical assistance program, covers air
5	ambulance transport services and requires no out-of-pocket expense by the
6	enrollee. Therefore, an enrollee in the state's medical assistance program
7	does not need an air ambulance membership agreement. It is unlawful for
8	[seller] to sell an air ambulance membership agreement to an enrollee in
9	the state's medical assistance program. By submitting this application, you
10	attest to the fact that you are not currently, nor do you plan to be, enrolled
11	in the state's medical assistance program.
12	If you are not currently enrolled in the state's medical assistance program
13	but become enrolled at any time during the duration of the membership
14	agreement, you are entitled to a pro-rated refund and may contact [seller] to
15	obtain your refund.''
16	→SECTION 2. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 367 IS CREATED TO
17	READ AS FOLLOWS:
18	If an individual or entity fails to comply with the requirements of Section 1 of this Act
19	and knowingly sells, offers for sale, or provides an air ambulance membership
20	agreement, as defined in Section 1 of this Act, to an individual who is enrolled in the
21	state's medical assistance program or fails to provide a refund as required by Section 1
22	of this Act, the individual or entity shall be fined five thousand dollars (\$5,000) per
23	occurrence. If an individual or entity is fined more than fifty thousand dollars
24	(\$50,000) in any calendar year, the individual or entity shall be required to initiate and
25	complete a corrective action plan, as approved by the Department of Law. If the
26	department determines that an individual or entity does not complete a corrective
27	action plan as required by this section, the individual or entity shall lose their right to

1 *any state-funded reimbursement for air ambulance transport services.*
