- AN ACT relating to members of the bar.
- 2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
- 3 → Section 1. KRS 21A.160 is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (1) The Supreme Court has power to provide for the organization,
 5 governance,[government] and membership of the[state] bar of Kentucky, and to
- 6 adopt rules and regulations to govern conduct and activity of the[state] bar and its
- 7 members, except that no member of the bar, without the member's annual written
- 8 <u>consent, shall be required to join or pay membership dues to any association or</u>
- 9 <u>entity beyond payment of fees required to support the costs associated with:</u>
- 10 (a) Admission to the bar; and
- 11 (b) Discipline of members of the bar.
- 12 (2) For purposes of this section, a member of the bar is any attorney licensed to
- 13 *practice law in Kentucky*.
