3	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:				
4		⇒s	ection 1. KRS 161.500 is amended to read as follows:		
5	(1)	At t	he close of each fiscal year, the retirement system shall add service credit to the		
6		acco	ount of each member who made contributions to his or her account during the		
7		year.			
8		<u>(a)</u>	Nonuniversity members are entitled to a full year of service credit if they have		
9			no more than five (5) unpaid days in a school or fiscal year under a contract		
10			requiring a work schedule of one hundred eighty-five (185) days or greater.		
11		<u>(b)</u>	University members are entitled to a full year of service credit if they have no		
12			more than five (5) unpaid days in a school or fiscal year under a contract		
13			requiring a work schedule of one hundred eighty (180) days or greater.		
14		<u>(c)</u>	A member who has more than the allowed number of unpaid days as		
15			specified in paragraph (a) or (b) of this subsection shall be allowed to		
16			recover up to a maximum of ten (10) of those days if the days were missed		
17			for the observance of religious holidays and the member submits a personal		
18			statement verifying the unpaid days were for the observance of religious		
19			<u>holidays.</u>		
20			1. The number of days recovered shall be included in the number of days		
21			worked for service credit purposes.		
22			2. The employer of a member recovering unpaid days as allowed for in		
23			this paragraph shall assign duties and responsibilities for recovered		
24			days comparable to the duties and responsibilities of the member on a		
25			typical contract day.		
26		<u>(d)</u>	In the event a member is paid for less than the required number of days for a		
27			full year of service credit, the member may purchase credit according to

1			administrative regulations established by the board of trustees.		
2		<u>(e)</u>	In no case shall more than one (1) year of service be credited for all service		
3			performed in one (1) fiscal year.		
4		<u>(f)</u>	Members who complete their employment contract prior to the close of a		
5			fiscal year and elect to retire prior to the close of a fiscal year shall have their		
6			service credit reduced by eight percent (8%) for each calendar month that the		
7			retirement becomes effective prior to July 1.		
8	(2)	Mer	nbers who are employed and paid for less than the number of days required in		
9		their	normal employment year shall be entitled to pro rata service credit for the		
10		fract	tional service. Such credit shall be based upon the number of days employed		
11		and	the number of days in the member's annual employment agreement or normal		
12		emp	loyment year.		
13	(3)	Serv	rice credit may not exceed the ratio between the school or fiscal year and the		
14		num	ber of months or fraction of a month the member is employed during that year.		
15	(4)	No	service credit shall be granted in the Teachers' Retirement System for service		
16		that	has been or will be used in qualifying for annuity benefit payments from		
17		anot	her retirement system financed wholly or in part by public funds.		
18		⇒s	ection 2. Whereas the General Assembly wants to acknowledge the diverse		
19	19 religions of the teachers employed in the Commonwealth and allow them to observe the				
20	holidays of those religions, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Act takes effect				
21	upo	upon its passage and approval by the Governor or upon its otherwise becoming a law.
