

1 AN ACT relating to reliable utility service.

2 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

3 ➔Section 1. KRS 278.030 is amended to read as follows:

- 4 (1) Every utility may demand, collect and receive fair, just and reasonable rates for the
5 services rendered or to be rendered by it to any person.
- 6 (2) Every utility shall furnish adequate, efficient, reliable, and reasonable service, and
7 may establish reasonable rules governing the conduct of its business and the
8 conditions under which it shall be required to render service.
- 9 (3) Every utility may employ in the conduct of its business suitable and reasonable
10 classifications of its service, patrons and rates. The classifications may, in any
11 proper case, take into account the nature of the use, the quality used, the quantity
12 used, the time when used, the purpose for which used, and any other reasonable
13 consideration.
- 14 (4) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (2) of this section, no utility shall
15 energize power to an electrical service in a manufactured home or mobile home
16 where the certified installer's seal is not present pursuant to KRS 227.570.
- 17 (5) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (2) of this section, no utility shall
18 energize power to an electrical service in a previously owned manufactured home
19 or previously owned mobile home where the Class B1 seal is not present pursuant
20 to KRS 227.600.
