1	AN ACT relating to medicinal cannabis.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 218A IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) As used in this section, "cannabis" has the same meaning as marijuana as
6	defined in KRS 218A.010.
7	(2) The Kentucky Center for Cannabis established in KRS 164.983, or its successor,
8	shall develop criteria for determining when sufficient scientific data and evidence
9	exists to demonstrate or indicate:
10	(a) That the use of cannabis is likely to have a medicinal, therapeutic, or
11	palliative effect for patients with a specified medical diagnosis;
12	(b) The appropriate dosage guidelines for the use of cannabis for medicinal,
13	therapeutic, or palliative effect by patients with a specific medical diagnosis;
14	(c) The appropriate method of consumption or use of cannabis for medicinal,
15	therapeutic, or palliative effect by patients with a specific medical diagnosis;
16	and
17	(d) That the use of cannabis for medicinal, therapeutic, or palliative effect by
18	patients with a specific medical condition is unlikely to cause serious
19	negative side effects.
20	(3) If the Kentucky Center for Cannabis research determines, based on the criteria
21	established pursuant to subsection (2) of this section, that sufficient scientific
22	data and evidence does exist to:
23	(a) Demonstrate that patients with a specific medical condition are likely to
24	receive medicinal, therapeutic, or palliative benefits from the use of
25	<u>cannabis;</u>
26	(b) Establish appropriate dosage guidelines for the use of cannabis for
27	medicinal, therapeutic, or palliative effect by a patient diagnosed with that

1		<u>be taking.</u>
2	<u>(6)</u>	If the Kentucky Center for Cannabis elects to establish and operate cannabis
3		product dispensing centers as permitted under subsection (4) of this section, the
4		center shall undertake all reasonable efforts necessary to ensure that those
5		centers are located in areas that ensure that residents in urban, suburban, and
6		rural areas have equitable access to the dispensing centers.
7	<u>(7)</u>	Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, an individual who
8		possesses cannabis distributed by the Kentucky Center for Cannabis in
9		accordance with this section shall not be subject to prosecution under:
10		<u>(a) KRS 218A.1421;</u>
11		(b) KRS 218A.1422; or
12		<u>(c) KRS 218A.1423.</u>
