Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

- 4 (1) The effective date of KRS 15.380 to 15.404 shall be December 1, 1998. All peace officers employed as of December 1, 1998, shall be deemed to have met all the

- 9 employed as of December 1, 1998, and are employed within *three hundred*

- 12 (b) Retired from employment with certified status on or after July 1, 2008, and
- are reemployed no later than one hundred (100) days from March 15, 2011,
- by a law enforcement agency subject to KRS 15.380 to 15.404; or
- 15 (c) Have successfully completed an approved basic training course approved and
- recognized by the Kentucky Law Enforcement Council pursuant to KRS
- 17 15.440(1)(d) when seeking employment with another law enforcement
- 18 agency.
- 19 (2) Any peace officers employed after December 1, 1998, shall comply with all
- 20 minimum standards specified in KRS 15.380 to 15.404 or comply with the
- 21 requirements set forth in KRS 15.440(1)(d)6. Persons newly employed or appointed
- after December 1, 1998, shall have one (1) year within which to gain certified status
- or they shall lose their law enforcement powers.
