1	A RESOLUTION recognizing April 2, 2023, as World Autism Awareness Day and
2	April 2023 as Autism Acceptance Month.
3	WHEREAS, autism disorders affect persons regardless of race, religion,
4	socioeconomic status, or geography; and
5	WHEREAS, autism is the fastest-growing developmental disorder in the United
6	States, with 1 in 36 children being diagnosed with autism spectrum disorder; and
7	WHEREAS, there are over 5 million people in the United States with autism and, as
8	of 2019, over 80,000 Kentuckians diagnosed with autism; and
9	WHEREAS, autism disorders are lifelong conditions that require support, training,
10	assistance, and advocacy on behalf of those individuals who suffer from such disorders;
11	and
12	WHEREAS, in 1972, the Autism Society, the nation's oldest grassroots autism
13	organization, launched National Autistic Children's week, which grew into Autism
14	Awareness Month; and
15	WHEREAS, on December 18, 2007, the United Nations General Assembly adopted
16	a resolution declaring World Autism Awareness Day by unanimous consent, encouraging
17	United Nations member states to take measures to raise awareness about autism disorders
18	throughout society and to promote early diagnosis and early behavioral intervention; and
19	WHEREAS, the aims for World Autism Awareness Day are to inform the general
20	public about the global health crisis of autism disorders, stress the importance of early
21	diagnosis and early intervention, and celebrate the unique talents and qualities of
22	individuals with autism disorders; and
23	WHEREAS, April is recognized as Autism Acceptance Month to increase
24	awareness about autism signs and symptoms and promote acceptance of individuals with
25	autism; and
26	WHEREAS, during April 2023, the aim of Autism Acceptance Month is to
27	celebrate differences and build an inclusive society for individuals with autism to live
