4	<u>(1)</u>	A one (1) year certificate for substitute teaching shall be issued by the Education
5		Professional Standards Board to any applicant who possesses fifteen (15)
6		semester hours of college credit in any subject area from a regionally or
7		nationally accredited postsecondary education institution.
8	<u>(2)</u>	A three (3) year certificate for substitute teaching shall be issued by the
9		Education Professional Standards Board to any applicant who possesses a
10		bachelor's degree in any subject area from a regionally or nationally accredited
11		postsecondary education institution.
12	<u>(3)</u>	A five (5) year certificate for substitute teaching shall be issued by the Education
13		Professional Standards Board to any applicant who:
14		(a) Holds a valid statement of eligibility for a Kentucky teaching certificate; or
15		(b) Previously held a Kentucky teaching certificate which required the
16		completion of a four (4) year teacher preparation program and a bachelor's
17		degree.
18	<u>(4)</u>	The issuance of a substitute teaching certificate shall be subject to the provisions
19		of KRS 161.120(1).
20	<u>(5)</u>	The one (1) year and three (3) year certificate for substitute teaching shall not be
21		valid for:
22		(a) Full-time employment with a school district as a substitute teacher; or
23		(b) The replacement of the teacher of record for more than twenty (20)
24		consecutive instructional days[Any applicant for emergency substitute
25		teaching who possesses a bachelor's degree in any subject area from a
26		regionally or nationally accredited institution of postsecondary education shall
27		be granted a certificate for substitute teaching from the Education Professional
