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AN ACT relating to state government.

2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

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→ Section 1. KRS 18A.035 is amended to read as follows:

- 4 (1) The secretary may from time to time designate in writing an employee of the
 5 cabinet to act for him <u>or her</u> in case of his <u>or her</u> absence or inability from any
 6 cause to discharge the powers and duties of his <u>or her</u> position. In this case, the
 7 powers and duties of the secretary shall devolve upon his <u>or her</u> designee.
- 8 (2) The secretary may request appropriate persons, including officers and employees in 9 the state service, to assist in the preparation and rating of tests. Department heads 10 shall cooperate to the fullest extent possible in making the services of their 11 employees available for such work.
- (3) (a) The secretary may enter into written agreements with an appointing authority
 which would provide for the delegation of his <u>or her</u> authority and power to
 the appointing authority. The secretary is prohibited from delegating any
 powers or authority pertaining to disciplinary actions, lay-offs, or registers.
- (b) All written agreements delegating the secretary's power and authority as
 provided in paragraph (a) of this subsection shall be specific in nature and
 renewed annually.
- 19 (c) A copy of the written agreements shall be forwarded to the Personnel Board.
- 20 (4) The secretary shall serve ex officio as a member of the board of trustees of the21 Kentucky Employees Retirement System.
