Section 2. KRS 186.510 is amended to read as follows:

7 The licensee shall have his or her license in his or her immediate possession at all times 8 when driving a motor vehicle and shall display it upon demand to [the circuit clerk or 9 examiner,] a peace officer, a member of the Department of Kentucky State Police, or a 10 field deputy or inspector of the Department of Vehicle Regulation or Transportation 11 Cabinet or, pursuant to KRS 67A.075 or 83A.088, a safety officer who is in the process 12 of securing information to complete an accident report. It shall be a defense to any charge 13 under this section if the person so charged produces in court an operator's license, issued 14 to him or her before his or her arrest and valid at the time of his or her arrest.
