3		→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 45A IS CREATED TO
4	REA	AD AS FOLLOWS:
5	<u>(1)</u>	The Finance and Administration Cabinet shall collect and maintain data on the
6		race and ethnicity of the majority owner and operator of any business issued or
7		administered a contract by the Finance and Administration Cabinet, that:
8		(a) Exceeds one thousand dollars (\$1,000); and
9		(b) Was awarded using the competitive process and small purchase procedures
10		<u>under KRS 45A.075.</u>
11	<u>(2)</u>	The race and ethnicity data collected under this section shall be captured using
12		categories that satisfy the current United States Office of Management and
13		Budget Standards for the Classification of Federal Data on Race and Ethnicity.
14	<u>(3)</u>	Any business issued a contract that meets the requirements of subsection (1) of
15		this section shall self-report the race and ethnicity of the majority owner of the
16		business to the Finance and Administration Cabinet. The business may select
17		more than one (1) category to reflect the race and ethnicity of the majority owner.
18	<u>(4)</u>	Collection of race and ethnicity data under this section shall be in a manner
19		prescribed by the Finance and Administration Cabinet pursuant to the authority
20		of KRS 45A.035.
21	<u>(5)</u>	Race and ethnicity data collected from a business under this section shall not be
22		used in the process to award state contracts under KRS 45A.075 and shall only be
23		used to comply with the reporting requirements under Section 2 of this Act.
24		→ SECTION 2. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 45A IS CREATED TO

26	<u>(1)</u>	Using the data collected under Section 1 of this Act, the Finance and
27		Administration Cabinet shall annually compile a report and submit it to the

1	Commission on Race and Access to Opportunity, within ninety (90) days
2	following the end of the fiscal year. The report shall include but not be limited to:
3	(a) A comprehensive list of the total number of contracts and amounts awarded
4	during the preceding fiscal year, including the business type and type of
5	goods, services, or commodities, to:
6	1. All contractors and subcontractors categorized by race and ethnicity
7	ownership;
8	2. Any business that is fifty-one percent (51%) or more owned and
9	operated by a woman; and
10	3. Any business that is fifty-one percent (51%) or more owned and
11	operated by a minority woman; and
12	(b) The rates of utilization of minority, women, and minority-owned and
13	women-owned businesses in comparison to the drawn workforce areas by
14	category of types of contracts awarded.
15	(2) If the reporting standards on race and ethnicity outlined in subsection (2) of
16	Section 1 of this Act are amended, the report shall utilize the new categories
17	established after twelve (12) months of data have been collected.
18	→ Section 3. Section 2 of this Act shall take effect July 1, 2024.
