10	<u>(2)</u>	When an eligible student changes his or her residence during the school year and		
11		the change in residence results in the student being assigned to a different school

13		<u>shal</u>	Il have the option to request the student, and any of the student's siblings	
14		enro	olled in the same school in any grade, remain enrolled in the original school,	
15		regardless of the transportation decision made under subsection (3) of this

17	<u>(3)</u>	(a)	Notwithstanding KRS 158.110, if the student remains enrolled in the	
18			original school, the school district shall provide transportation to the	
19			original school from the student's new residence, except as provided in	
20			paragraph (b) of this subsection.	
21		<u>(b)</u>	The superintendent may deny the transportation request if he or she	
22			determines the distance and travel time that the student would spend in	
23			transport is impracticable. The district shall report the transportation denial	
24			and supporting rationale to the Kentucky Department of Education.
