3	Be it	t enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
4		→ SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 161 IS CREATED TO
5	REA	AD AS FOLLOWS:
6	<u>(1)</u>	The Educators Employment Liability Insurance Program is hereby established in
7		the Kentucky Department of Education for the purpose of providing educators
8		employment liability insurance to protect all certified employees of Kentucky
9		public schools from liability for judgments or settlements that are in excess of the
10		coverage provided in Section 2 of this Act.
11	<u>(2)</u>	Not later than July 1, 2024, the department shall contract with an insurance
12		agency, broker, company, or third-party administrator to provide excess liability
13		coverage to the coverage required in Section 2 of this Act for an additional
14		amount of not less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence and
15		three million dollars (\$3,000,000) aggregate for each certified employee, which
16		shall be inclusive of legal fees. The department shall notify each certified
17		employee that the coverage has been provided.
18	<u>(3)</u>	If the certified educators' association with the largest number of members in the
19		Commonwealth provides greater, more comprehensive coverage than the
20		amounts provided in subsection (2) of this section, then the coverage provided by
21		the program in subsection (2) shall be at least equivalent to that amount.
22	<u>(4)</u>	The purchase of liability insurance under this section shall not constitute a
23		waiver of any immunity or defense the insured may now or in the future assert
24		under state or federal law, regulation, or rule.
25	<u>(5)</u>	The Kentucky Board of Education shall promulgate administrative regulations in
26		accordance with KRS Chapter 13A to implement the insurance program under
27		this section.

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1	<u>(6)</u>	(a) The educators employment liability insurance program fund is hereby
2		created as a trust and agency account fund in the State Treasury to be
3		administered by the Kentucky Department of Education for the purpose of
4		providing educators' employment liability insurance to certified employees
5		as described in this section.
6		(b) The fund shall consist of general fund appropriations, gifts and grants from
7		public and private sources, and federal funds. All moneys included in the
8		fund shall be appropriated for the purposes set forth in this section.
9		(c) Any unalloted or unencumbered balances in the fund shall be invested as
10		provided in KRS 42.500(9). Income earned from the investments shall be
11		credited to the fund.
12		(d) Notwithstanding KRS 45.229, any fund balance at the close of the fiscal
13		year shall not lapse but shall be carried forward to the next fiscal year and
