| 3 | WHEREAS, oral health is a critical component of overall health that has effects on |
| 4 | speech, nutrition, social development, productivity, and quality of life; and |
| 5 | WHEREAS, raising awareness about oral health and invasive diseases like oral |
| 6 | cancer is a fundamental concern of oral health professionals across Kentucky; and |
| 7 | WHEREAS, oral cancer kills more than 11,000 Americans yearly and is expected |
| 8 | to kill 170 Kentuckians in 2023; and |
| 9 | WHEREAS, 54,000 people in the United States will be diagnosed with oral cancer |
| 10 | in 2023, including an estimated 870 people in Kentucky; and |
| 11 | WHEREAS, oral cancer affects almost twice as many men as women; and |
| 12 | WHEREAS, access to dental care has been proven to be a major factor in early |
| 13 | diagnosis of oral cancer; and |
| 14 | WHEREAS, Kentucky has improved access to dental care for children and those |
| 15 | individuals at a greater risk of contracting oral cancer; and |
| 16 | WHEREAS, early detection and self-examination also greatly increase the chance |
| 17 | of identifying oral cancer in its early stages; and |
| 18 | WHEREAS, this body urges all residents in the Commonwealth of Kentucky to |
| 19 | perform self-examination regularly and to see their dental health professional in order to |
| 20 | cultivate sound oral health; and |
| 21 | WHEREAS, this body further recognizes the importance of maintaining sound oral |
| 22 | health habits and directs all residents' attention to the prevalence of oral cancer in their |
| 23 | communities and throughout this Commonwealth; |
