1	A RESOLUTION honoring the duPont Manual High School Lady Crimsons, 2022
2	Kentucky High School Athletic Association Class 3A Girls Cross-Country champions.
3	WHEREAS, on October 29, 2022, at the Bourbon County Cross-Country Course in
4	Paris, the duPont Manual High School Lady Crimsons captured the 2022 Kentucky High
5	School Athletic Association (KHSAA) Class 3A Girls Cross-Country championship; and
6	WHEREAS, the Lady Crimsons won the meet with an incredibly strong team effort
7	that saw all five runners whose finishes counted toward the team score finish on the top
8	30, and their team score of 77 bested the runners-up from Assumption High School by 29
9	points; and
10	WHEREAS, the Lady Crimsons were paced by senior star Jessica Secor, a
11	University of Tennessee commit, who finished second in the individual race with a time
12	of 18 minutes, 7.60 seconds; and
13	WHEREAS, the other four Lady Crimsons whose scores counted in the team event
14	were Bailee Montgomery (10th place, 18:51.70), Emerson Wyatt (17th place, 19:10.60),
15	Maggie May (22nd place, 19:30.50), and Flora Biro (30th place, 19:47.80); and
16	WHEREAS, other members of the Lady Crimson squad included Mary Kate French
17	and Gwyneth Cunningham, who both ran at the state finals, and Juliet Bailey, Lily
18	Cashman, and Sienna Underwood; and
19	WHEREAS, the Lady Crimsons were led by head coach Tim Holman, who was
20	assisted by assistant coaches Jill Bickel, Stephanie Fish, and Josh Hartlage, as well as
21	team manager Emily Holland; and
22	WHEREAS, this championship is the fourth in the history of the Manual program,
23	and its first since 2017; and
24	WHEREAS, the dedication, athleticism, and spirit displayed by the duPont Manual
25	Lady Crimsons Cross-Country team sets a noble example for young athletes across the
26	Commonwealth and is truly worthy of public recognition;
