

1 A RESOLUTION honoring the South Laurel Senior League All-Stars, 2022 state
2 champions.

3 WHEREAS, the South Laurel Senior League All-Stars baseball team swept the
4 Henry County All-Stars in two games by scores of 13 to 0 and 13 to 3 to capture the 2022
5 Kentucky Senior League state championship; and

6 WHEREAS, South Laurel's 13 to 0 victory in the first game was highlighted by the
7 dominant pitching of Cole Harville, who tossed a no-hitter and struck out 13 Henry
8 County batters; and

9 WHEREAS, in the second game, it was South Laurel's offense that came alive late,
10 scoring seven runs in the final two innings to end the game; and

11 WHEREAS, as state champions, South Laurel represented Kentucky at the Central
12 Region Tournament in Peru, Indiana; and

13 WHEREAS, South Laurel went 4 and 0 in pool play, but they were defeated by the
14 squad from LaSalle-Peru, Indiana in the first round of the knockout stage; and

15 WHEREAS, members of the team included Isaac Alsip, Will Alsip, Austin Byrd,
16 Keaton Creech, Tyler Curry, Toby Dotson, Cole Harville, Brayden House, Noah Smith,
17 Reece Noble, Vince Sizemore, Jack Vaughn, and Jamison West; and

18 WHEREAS, South Laurel was coached by Steve Byrd, Harrison Byrd, and Garrett
19 Alsip; and

20 WHEREAS, the hard work and athleticism shown by the South Laurel Senior
21 League All-Stars are a testament to what is right with youth sports in this country, and
22 their efforts and achievements should be publicly recognized;
