

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Dr.
2 Harvey Allsbrook Page.

3 WHEREAS, Dr. Harvey Allsbrook Page was born in North Carolina on October 3,
4 1927, to Harvey Lee and Clara Allsbrook Page; and

5 WHEREAS, Dr. Page spent his life serving his country and his community as a
6 veteran of the United States Army, a devoted member of the Pikeville United Methodist
7 Church, and a physician; and

8 WHEREAS, Dr. Page was known to his community as a wonderful person,
9 physician, friend, and neighbor. He was known as one of the best southern and country
10 doctors by members of the community, combining honesty, kindness, and common sense
11 when treating his patients and providing sound medical advice; and

12 WHEREAS, a model physician, Dr. Page had the ability to put his patients at ease
13 when treating them. He knew how to combine both medical and human care. In the
14 words of one of his patients, "you never felt like you were going to the doctor...I was
15 going to chat with a friend"; and

16 WHEREAS, as a mentor to others, Dr. Page would counsel and encourage those
17 who sought to enter the medical profession and would attend the medical school
18 ceremonies of his mentees; and

19 WHEREAS, Dr. Page left this earth on March 15, 2023, survived by his son, John
20 Brooks Page; daughter, Deborah Osborne Page; sister, Ann Braswell;, four
21 grandchildren; and eight great-grandchildren; and

22 WHEREAS, Dr. Page will be remembered for his kindness, gentleness, wisdom,
23 and love and devotion to his family and community. He was a perfect gentleman, a
24 perfect example of what a medical professional should be, and a true icon of his
25 community;
