3	WHEREAS, child care providers help children develop social, language, and
4	problem-solving skills so they can reach their full potential in life and contribute to the
5	future growth of Kentucky; and
6	WHEREAS, child care providers support business and industry by providing
7	children with safe environments so parents can consistently go to work; and
8	WHEREAS, there are approximately 1,698 child care centers, 243 licensed or
9	certified family child care homes, and 38 family child care providers caring for children
10	in Kentucky; and
11	WHEREAS, one-half of all Kentuckians live in a child care desert where there are
12	either no child care providers or an insufficient number of child care slots; and
13	WHEREAS, the median income is \$22,620 for child care teachers, \$27,560 for
14	family child care teachers and administrators, and \$31,828 for child care center directors;
15	and
16	WHEREAS, about 20 percent of child care providers hold second jobs; and
17	WHEREAS, it is essential that all of Kentuckians understand the importance of
18	supporting child care providers in their careers and in their goal of providing care and
19	opportunity for children and their families;
20	NOW, THEREFORE,
