3	WHEREAS, Nathan Sesco is a resident of Pikeville, Kentucky; and
4	WHEREAS, Nathan Sesco served with honor in the United States Army for seven
5	years, serving in Operation Joint Forge in Bosnia and Operation Iraqi Freedom 2; and
6	WHEREAS, Nathan Sesco has been inducted into the Kentucky Veterans Hall of
7	Fame, an august foundation where inductees are selected for valorous military service to
8	the country and for their military and civilian service to the community, state, and nation;

10	WHEREAS, Nathan Sesco has been serving as the State Commander of the
11	Veterans of Foreign Wars, Department of Kentucky since 2022; and
12	WHEREAS, Nathan Sesco's leadership of the department has been exemplary; and
13	WHEREAS, the Veterans of Foreign Wars is a long-standing nonprofit corporation
14	advocating for 1.7 million veterans of all ages and around 15,000 veterans distributed
15	among ninety posts across the Commonwealth; and
16	WHEREAS, Nathan Sesco has the exceptional distinction of being the first veteran
17	of the Iraq War and the first person from Pike County to serve as the State Commander;
18	NOW, THEREFORE,
19	Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of
20	Kentucky:
21	→ Section 1. The Senate hereby honors Nathan Sesco for his selection and current
22	service as State Commander of the Veterans of Foreign Wars, Department of Kentucky
23	and his exceptional service to our nation and the Commonwealth through his service in
24	the United States Army, and furthermore acknowledges the distinction of his being the
25	first State Commander to be a veteran of the Iraq War as well as the first chosen from
26	Pike County.
27	→ Section 2. The Senate extends its sincere gratitude for his service to the nation
