1	A RESOLUTION recognizing and honoring Nucor Corporation's investment of
2	capital and workforce development in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
3	WHEREAS, Nucor Corporation is the largest steel and steel products manufacturer
4	in the United States and the global leader in steelmaking sustainability; and
5	WHEREAS, Nucor Corporation is the largest recycler of scrap material in North
6	America; and
7	WHEREAS, Nucor Corporation recycles approximately 20 million tons of ferrous
8	scrap metal annually to produce new steel that is 100% recyclable; and
9	WHEREAS, by recycling scrap to make new steel, Nucor Corporation's greenhouse
10	gas intensity is less than one-fourth the global steelmaking average and one-fifth the
11	intensity of a traditional blast furnace producer; and
12	WHEREAS, Nucor Corporation employs more than 31,000 teammates working
13	safely at over 300 operating facilities in North America, with approximately 2,000
14	teammates at more than a dozen locations in Kentucky; and
15	WHEREAS, the median pay for Nucor Corporation production teammates over the
16	last 3 years has averaged more than \$100,000 per year; and
17	WHEREAS, to reinforce its culture, the majority of Nucor Corporation teammates
18	below the officer level are treated as if they are owners of the company, historically
19	receiving 10% of Nucor Corporation's earnings in a profit sharing plan in addition to
20	their salary; and
21	WHEREAS, the profit sharing amount returned to Nucor Corporation teammates
22	was a company-record \$826 million in 2022, and the total is expected to approach \$1
23	billion in 2023; and
24	WHEREAS, every Nucor Corporation teammate and their dependents are eligible
25	to receive a \$4,000 per year scholarship to college or vocational school, which
26	nationwide has amounted to more than \$115 million awarded to nearly 25,000 children
27	since the program's inception in 1974; and
