On page 1, delete lines 18 to 21 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"(e) Criminal misconduct against the spouse committed:

1. Within the last five (5) years of the marriage prior to the filing of the petition for dissolution; or

2. Any time after the filing of the petition for dissolution prior to the final disposition of property;

that results in a conviction for a violent felony offense as defined in KRS 532.200 or criminal attempt to commit murder under KRS 506.010."; and

On page 2, line 14, after "**(a)**", insert:

" Subject to the limitation of paragraph (b) of this subsection."; and

On page 2, after line 19, insert the following:

"(b) A spouse who is the victim of a crime perpetrated by the other spouse as described in subsection (1)(e) of this section shall be entitled to exclude from marital property up to twenty-five percent (25%) of any retirement benefits he or she individually acquired during the marriage. The court may, in its discretion, increase that exclusion up to one hundred percent (100%) considering the totality of the circumstances."; and

On page 2, line 20, delete "**(b)**" and insert "**(c)**" in lieu thereof; and

"(5) A spouse who is the victim of a crime perpetrated by the other spouse as described in subsection (1)(e) of this section shall be entitled to exclude from marital property up to twenty-five percent (25%) of any whole life insurance policy he or she acquired during the marriage. The court may, in its discretion, increase that exclusion up to one hundred percent (100%) considering the totality of the circumstances."
