2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:			
3		→ Section 1. KRS 161.102 is amended to read as follows:		
4	<u>(1)</u>	Notwithstanding KRS 161.1211, the Education Professional Standards Board		
5		shall issue a one (1) year emergency certificate for substitute teaching to any		
6		applicant who possesses a minimum of a high school diploma or High School		
7		Equivalency Diploma and has met the requirements to receive the certificate as		
8		set forth in administrative regulation promulgated by the Education Professional		
9		Standards Board, subject to the provisions of KRS 161.120(1).		
10	<u>(2)</u>	The Education Professional Standards Board shall issue a five (5) year certificate		
11		for substitute teaching to any applicant who possesses a bachelor's degree in any		
12		subject area from a regionally or nationally accredited postsecondary education		
13		institution.		
14	<u>(3)</u>	The Education Professional Standards Board shall issue a ten (10) year		
15		certificate for substitute teaching to any applicant who:		
16		(a) Holds a valid statement of eligibility for a Kentucky teaching certificate;		
17		(b) Previously held a Kentucky teaching certificate which required the		
18		completion of a four (4) year teacher preparation program and a bachelor's		
19		degree; or		
20		(c) Currently holds or previously held a valid out-of-state teaching certificate		
21		which required the completion of a four (4) year teacher preparation		
22		program and a bachelor's degree.		
23	<u>(4)</u>	The issuance of a substitute teaching certificate shall be subject to the provisions		
24		of KRS 161.120(1).		
25	<u>(5)</u>	The one (1) year emergency certificate for substitute teaching authorized in		
26		subsection (1) of this section shall not be valid for:		
27		(a) Full-time employment with a school district as a substitute teacher; or

1	<u>(b)</u>	The replacement of the teacher of record for more than twenty (20)
2		consecutive instructional days[Any applicant for emergency substitute
3		teaching who possesses a bachelor's degree in any subject area from a
4		regionally or nationally accredited institution of postsecondary education shall
5		be granted a certificate for substitute teaching from the Education Professional
6		Standards Board subject to the provisions of KRS 161.120(1). This certificate
7		shall enable the applicant to apply for substitute teaching in any subject area
8		for any grade level in any local school district].
