| 5  | <u>(1)</u> | The Kentucky Department of Education may enter into an agreement with any         |
| 6  |            | building and construction trade organization to develop a training program for    |
| 7  |            | school counselors providing services to students in the Commonwealth. The         |
| 8  |            | purpose of the training program shall be to promote building and construction     |
| 9  |            | trades and training facilities available to students by making school counselors  |
| 10 |            | aware of what is available to students participating in the building and          |
| 11 |            | construction trade. The training program shall include information relating to:   |
| 12 |            | (a) The pay and benefits available to people who work in the building and         |
| 13 |            | construction trades; and  |
| 14 |            | (b) Job opportunities, pre-apprenticeships, apprenticeships, and pathways         |
| 15 |            | within the building and construction trade industry.                              |
| 16 | <u>(2)</u> | The participating trade organization shall ensure ample opportunities for school  |
