3	⇒s	ection 1. KRS 341.413 is amended to read as follows:
4	Notwithst	anding any state law to the contrary, for unemployment insurance claims filed
5	between J	anuary 27, 2020, and <u>September 6, 2021</u> [December 31, 2020]:
6	(1) [Up	on request of the alleged overpayment recipient,]The secretary shall [may]
7	waiv	ve an overpayment of benefits if he or she finds the overpayment:
8	(a)	Was made without fault on the part of the recipient; and
9	(b)	Recovery would be contrary to equity and good conscience;
10	(2) [(a)	Requests for waiver of overpayment of benefits under subsection (1) of this
11		section shall be made within thirty (30) days after the date the secretary mails
12		to the alleged overpayment recipient the notification of the overpayment
13		determination via first class United States Mail. The secretary shall resend
14		any notices of overpayment sent prior to March 12, 2021. The new notices
15		shall restart the thirty (30) day period for the alleged overpayment recipient to
16		request repayment waiver.
17	(b) -	Notice of the secretary's determination shall include information explaining
18		how the alleged overpayment recipient may request a waiver of overpayment
19		and explain how the alleged overpayment recipient may appeal the secretary's
20		final determination by requesting an appeal of the determination pursuant to
21		KRS 341.420.
22	(c) -	The secretary shall not initiate overpayment recovery until lapse of the thirty
23		(30) day period provided in this subsection.
24	(d)	
25		overpayments were paid from Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic
26		Security (CARES) Act dollars and a waiver was not granted pursuant to
27		subsection (1) of this section.

Section 2. Whereas it is vital to address pending claims for benefits and pending
claims of alleged overpayments, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Act takes
effect upon its passage and approval by the Governor or upon its otherwise becoming a
law.
