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AN ACT relating to the Animal Control Advisory Board.

## 2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

- Section 1. KRS 258.117 is repealed, reenacted, and amended to read as follows:
   (1) The Animal Control Advisory Board is hereby created for the purposes of
   evaluating applications for and reviewing disbursements from the animal control
   and care fund, creating training programs, and other duties relating to animal
   control and care in the counties of the Commonwealth. The Animal Control
   Advisory Board shall promulgate administrative regulations to carry out the
   provisions of this section.
- 10 (2) The advisory board shall be attached to the Kentucky Department of Agriculture for
  administrative purposes.
- 12 (3) The advisory board shall be composed of the following members appointed by the13 Governor as specified:
- 14 (a) <u>One (1) member[Two (2) members]</u> selected from a list of three (3) submitted
  15 by the Kentucky Animal Control Association;
- 16 (b) <u>One (1) member[Two (2) members]</u> selected from a list of three (3) submitted
  17 by the Kentucky Veterinary Medical Association;
- 18 (c) One (1) member selected from a list of three (3) representatives of registered
   19 nonprofit organizations whose missions prioritize spay and neuter advocacy
- 20for companion animals submitted by the Kentucky Veterinary Medical21Association:
- 22 (d)[(c)] One (1) member[Two (2) members] selected from a list of three (3)
   23 submitted by the Kentucky Farm Bureau;
- 24 (e)[(d)] One (1) member[Two (2) members] selected from a list of three (3)
   25 submitted by the Kentucky Association of Counties;
- 26 (f)[(e)] One (1) member[Two (2) members] selected from a list of three (3)
   27 submitted by the Kentucky Houndsmen Association;[and]

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1		(g)[(f)] One (1) member[Two (2) members] selected from a list of three (3)
2		submitted by the Kentucky League of Cities; and
3		(h) One (1) member selected from a list of three (3) submitted by Kentucky
4		Animal Action.
5	(4)	Appointed members shall serve for a term of four (4) years. Vacancies shall be
6		filled in the same manner as the original appointment for the unexpired portion of
7		the term.
8	(5)	Members of the advisory board shall receive one hundred dollars (\$100) per day for
9		attendance at meetings and shall be entitled to reimbursement for expenses incurred
10		for travel. No per diem or travel expenses shall be paid except for meetings of the
11		full advisory board.
12	(6)	The advisory board shall elect one (1) of its members to serve as chair for a term of
13		two (2) years.
14	(7)	The advisory board shall meet quarterly or upon the call of the chair.
15		→ Section 2. On the effective date of this Act, the Animal Control Advisory Board
16	shall	be dissolved and reconstituted, and all new members shall be appointed pursuant to
17	the r	equirements of Section 1 of this Act.
18		$\rightarrow$ Section 3. The initial appointments made after the effective date of this Act
19	shall	be staggered so that the appointments from subsections (3)(c) and (d) of Section 1
20	of th	s Act shall expire at two (2) years and appointments from subsections (3)(e) and (g)
21	of S	ection 1 of this Act shall expire at three (3) years from the dates of initial
22	appo	intment.
