1 AN ACT relating to the Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources and declaring 2 an emergency.

3 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

- 4 → Section 1. KRS 150.021 is amended to read as follows:
- 5 The Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources shall constitute an independent (1)department of state government within the meaning of KRS Chapter 12, and shall 6 7 be administratively attached to the *Department of Agriculture* Tourism, Arts and 8 Heritage Cabinet only for those limited functions and purposes expressly requested 9 by the department to be performed by the Department of Agriculture Tourism, 10 Arts and Heritage Cabinet. The department shall have sole discretion as to which 11 functions shall be deemed necessary for the efficient operation of the department 12 and the properties in its custody and control. The department shall consist of a 13 commissioner, a Fish and Wildlife Resources Commission, the Division of Law 14 Enforcement, and other agents and employees provided for in this chapter. The 15 department shall enforce the laws and regulations adopted under this chapter 16 relating to wildlife and shall exercise all powers necessarily incident thereto.
 - (2) (a) The Finance and Administration Cabinet shall assess the Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources each fiscal year a fee in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the debt service associated with all phases and implementation of the capital project to replace, repair, or maintain the two (2) way radio system utilized by the Department of Kentucky State Police.
 - (b) The fee shall be assessed on each phase of the implementation of the two (2) way radio system and shall continue to be assessed until all debt for the system has been retired.
- On *the effective date of this Act*[April 13, 2022], copies of any records, files, or documents, including any legal documents or memoranda, associated with functions of the Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources[that were previously]

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performed by the Tourism, Arts and Heritage Cabinet but for which it is no longer

deemed responsible, shall be transmitted to the department.

- 3 (4) The department shall not be subject to reorganization under KRS Chapter 12.
- 4 → Section 2. KRS 150.022 is amended to read as follows:

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- The Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources Commission shall consist of nine

 (9) members, one (1) from each commission district, as set out by the commissioner

 with the approval of the commission, and not more than five (5) of the same

 political party.
 - (2) The <u>Commissioner of Agriculture</u>[Governor] shall appoint the members of the commission subject to confirmation by the Senate as described in subsection (3) of this section. Each of the members shall be appointed for a term ending on December 31 of the fourth calendar year following his or her appointment, except that a member's term shall continue until his or her successor is duly appointed and confirmed by the Senate, but no later than one (1) year following the expiration of the member's term. If after one (1) year a successor has not been duly appointed and confirmed by the Senate, the commissioner's seat for that district shall be vacant until a successor is duly appointed and confirmed by the Senate. A member shall serve no more than two (2) full terms, not including any partial term that a member may additionally serve. A person who has been convicted of a felony offense, in Kentucky or under the law of any other state, or any other law of the United States shall not be eligible to serve on the commission.
- 22 Vacancies through the expiration of terms of the members of the commission (3) (a) 23 shall be filled appointment **Commissioner** by by the 24 Agriculture[Governor] from a list of five (5) names from each commission 25 district, recommended and submitted by the sportsmen of each respective 26 district.
 - (b) When the term of a member expires, the commissioner shall call a meeting of

the sportsmen in that district not later than thirty (30) days prior to the expiration of the member's term. Notice of the meeting shall be given by publication pursuant to KRS Chapter 424.

- (c) At the meeting, the sportsmen in attendance shall select and submit to the Commissioner of Agriculture[Governor] a list of five (5) residents and citizens of the district who have held hunting and fishing licenses in Kentucky or another state for at least the previous five (5) consecutive years, or who have been hunting and fishing in the Commonwealth for the previous five (5) consecutive years while license-exempt under KRS 150.170, and who are well informed on the subject of wildlife conservation and restoration. Each sportsman may vote for one (1) candidate only, and the list submitted to the Commissioner of Agriculture[Governor] shall be made up of the names of the five (5) candidates receiving the five (5) highest vote totals.
- (d) The <u>Commissioner of Agriculture</u>[Governor] shall appoint a successor to the member whose term has expired no later than January 20 of the year following the year in which the member's term expired.
- (4) Upon appointment to the Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources Commission, each commissioner shall execute a bond of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) in favor of the Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources, the premium on this bond to be paid out of department funds.
- 21 (5) In the event of vacancies other than by expiration, the <u>Commissioner of</u>
 22 <u>Agriculture</u>[Governor] shall fill the vacancy for the unexpired part of the term from
 23 the names remaining on the list previously submitted for the district from which the
 24 vacancy arose. An appointee chosen under this subsection shall not serve on the
 25 commission until duly confirmed by the Senate.
- 26 (6) Each member of the commission shall take the constitutional oath of office.
- 27 (7) The <u>Commissioner of Agriculture</u>[Governor] shall remove any member of the

commission for cause under subsection (2) of this section and may remove a member of the commission for nonfeasance, neglect of duty, or misconduct in office; but shall first deliver to the member a copy of all charges in writing and afford to him or her an opportunity for an administrative hearing to be conducted in accordance with KRS Chapter 13B.

- 6 (8) Each member of the commission shall be entitled to reimbursement for actual and
 7 necessary traveling and other expenses incurred by him or her in the discharge of
 8 his or her official duties and to be paid from the game and fish fund.
- 9 (9) A majority of the commission shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of any business, for the performance of any duty or for the exercise of any power vested in the commission.
- 12 (10) The department shall have its principal office in Franklin County, and is authorized 13 to purchase all supplies, equipment, and printed forms and to issue any notices and 14 publications as the commissioner may deem necessary to carry out the provisions of 15 this chapter.
- 16 (11) The word "sportsman" as used in this section shall mean a resident hunter or 17 fisherman who has been licensed in Kentucky for each of the past two (2) 18 consecutive years.
- → Section 3. KRS 150.061 is amended to read as follows:
 - (1) Notwithstanding any provisions of KRS Chapter 18A, 42, 45, 45A, 56, or 64 to the contrary, the commission shall have the sole authority to appoint a commissioner of the Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources, who shall be a person with knowledge of and experience in the requirements for the protection, conservation and restoration of the wildlife resources of the state. The commission shall be the sole contracting body for the purposes of KRS Chapter 45A and shall submit any proposed personal service contract with a commissioner to the Government Contact Review Committee for its review pursuant to KRS 45A.690 to 45A.725. The

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1 commissioner shall serve for a defined employment contract term not to exceed 2 four (4) years and shall be subject to:

- (a) Annual review by the commission in closed, executive session;
- 4 (b) Removal by the commission for the same cause and in the same manner in
 5 which the *Commissioner of Agriculture*[Governor] may remove a member of
 6 the commission; and
- 7 (c) Reappointment by the commission.

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- 8 (2) The commissioner shall receive such compensation as the commission may solely
 9 determine, and shall be reimbursed for all actual and necessary travel and other
 10 expenses incurred by him or her in the performance of his or her official duties.
 - (3) Before entering upon the duties of his or her office, the commissioner shall take and subscribe to the constitutional oath of office, and shall, in addition thereto, swear or affirm that he or she holds no other public office, nor any position upon or under any political committee or party. Upon appointment by the commission, the commissioner shall execute a bond of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) in favor of the Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources, the premium on said bond to be paid out of department funds.
 - (4) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the commissioner shall be the sole appointing authority for the department for the purposes of KRS Chapter 18A and shall have general supervision and control of all activities, functions, appointments, and employees of the department. He or she shall enforce all provisions of the laws of the state relating to wild animals, birds, fish and amphibians, and shall exercise all powers necessarily incident thereto not specifically conferred on the commission. The commissioner shall make an annual report of all receipts and disbursements and file same with the Secretary of State of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
 - (5) If federal or other grant funds become available to pay their salaries, the

commissioner may appoint and employ other persons that he or she may deem necessary or desirable to accomplish the purposes of this chapter. The commissioner shall determine the compensation, duties, and terms of employment of these employees, and grant funded, time-limited positions shall be approved by the commission as needed. Employees whose salaries are funded through federal or other grant funds shall not be counted in any tally of permanent employees made for employee cap or budgetary purposes.

- 15 (b) Boats propelled by human power employing the use of hand or foot operation; 16 and
- 17 (c) Federally regulated commercial vessels;

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- 18 (3) "Owner" means a person, other than a lienholder, having the property in or title to a
 19 motorboat. The term includes a person entitled to the use or possession of a
 20 motorboat subject to an interest in another person, reserved or created by agreement
 21 and securing payment or performance of an obligation, but the term excludes a
 22 lessee under a lease not intended as security;
- 23 (4) "Personal watercraft" means a vessel which uses an internal combustion engine to 24 power a jet pump for its primary source of propulsion and is designed to be 25 operated by a person sitting, standing, or kneeling on the vessel rather than to be 26 operated by a person sitting or standing inside the vessel;
- 27 (5) "Safe boating certificate" means a document attesting the successful completion of

- 5 functions and purposes expressly requested by the department to be performed by the
- 6 Department of Agriculture [Tourism, Arts and Heritage Cabinet]. The department shall
- 7 have sole discretion as to which functions shall be deemed necessary for the efficient

- 9 Transportation Cabinet shall be responsible for administering the boat numbering,

- → Section 6. KRS 235.130 is amended to read as follows:
- 12 (1) No person acting for himself or another shall buy or trade for any motorboat
- without receiving the certificate of title issued for that boat with a certificate of
- transfer endorsed thereon. If the motorboat has not been issued a certificate of title
- as noted on the certificate of registration, the person shall receive a completed
- assignment of title on a boat transaction record and the certificate of registration.
- 17 (2) It shall be the duty of the purchaser to promptly submit the endorsed certificate of
- 18 title or boat transaction record and certificate of registration to the county clerk of
- 19 the county of the purchaser's residence or in which the motorboat is to be
- 20 principally operated. The purchaser shall apply for a new certificate of title and
- 21 registration pursuant to KRS 235.050. The county clerk shall thereupon issue to the
- 22 purchaser a transfer of registration bearing the same data and information. The clerk
- shall forward the endorsed certificate of title or boat transaction record and
- certificate of registration and new application for title and registration to the
- 25 Transportation Cabinet. Except when registration is prohibited by law, any
- 26 unexpired registration shall remain valid after transfer until expiration occurs
- according to law.

(3) For transferring the registration, the clerk shall collect a fee of five dollars (\$5). The clerk shall retain two dollars (\$2), the Transportation Cabinet shall receive two dollars (\$2) and the Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources administratively attached to the *Department of Agriculture*[Tourism, Arts and Heritage Cabinet] shall receive one dollar (\$1). The fee received by the Transportation Cabinet shall be deposited in a trust and agency account for use by the Transportation Cabinet in defraying the cost of implementing and operating the boat titling and registration program. The fee for transferring the title shall be as required by KRS 235.085.

The appointments made by executive orders under KRS 150.022 7 before the effective date of this Act, of commissioners to represent the Second, Third, 8 Seventh, Eighth, and Ninth Commission Districts shall expire and be vacated as of the 9 effective date of this Act. The lists of candidates for appointment generated as a result of 10 district meetings held in the Second, Third, Seventh, Eighth, and Ninth Commission 11 Districts shall be delivered to the Commissioner of Agriculture on the effective date of 12 this Act. The Commissioner of Agriculture shall make appointments by executive order 13 and deliver a copy of the executive order and all information required by KRS 11.160 to 14 the Clerk of the Senate within 10 days of the receipt of the lists. Whereas the orderly administration of the Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources and the interests of Kentuckians who enjoy hunting, fishing, boating, and other outdoor activities supported by the department deserve to be free from executive branch decisions based on considerations other than the best interests of the department and the Kentuckians it serves, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Act takes effect upon its passage and approval by the Governor or upon its otherwise becoming a law.

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
