

On page 4, lines 3 to 18, delete all language and insert the following in lieu thereof:

"(4) (a) The Council on Postsecondary Education shall develop new student orientation materials that include:

- **<u>1.</u>** The full text of the First Amendment of the Constitution of the United States;
- 2. Discussion and resources on the principles and importance of free speech and viewpoint diversity;
- 3. Historical examples demonstrating the necessity of protecting free speech, including unpopular speech, in the United States and other nations;
- 4. The policies adopted by the institution pursuant to subsection (2) of Section 3 of this Act to protect free speech on the institution's campus; and
- 5. Instructions on the procedure to report an alleged infringement upon freedom of expression on a postsecondary campus to the council.
- (b) Any new student orientation program offered by a public postsecondary education institution shall distribute the new student orientation materials developed by the council in accordance with paragraph (a) of this subsection to participants."; and

On page 4, line 19, change "<u>(b)</u>" to "<u>(c)</u>"; and

On page 5, lines 15 to 23, delete all language and insert the following in lieu thereof:

"(b) The individual's duties shall include identifying at-risk student populations and

(6) The Council on Postsecondary Education shall have the authority to promulgate administrative regulations pursuant to KRS Chapter 13A to implement this section, including but not limited to administrative regulations imposing reporting and oversight mechanisms to ensure compliance with this section.".
