| 3 | Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky: |
| 4 | →SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 158 IS CREATED TO |
| 5 | READ AS FOLLOWS: |
| 6 | (1) As used in this section, unless the context otherwise requires: |
| 7 | (a) "Community eligibility provision" means the school meal reimbursement |
| 8 | program administered by the United States Department of Agriculture to |
| 9 | reimburse low-income schools for offering no-charge meals to all enrolled |
| 10 | students governed by 7 C.F.R. pt. 245; |
| 11 | (b) ''Identified student percentage'' means the percentage of student population |
| 12 | used by the United States Department of Agriculture to determine the |
| 13 | eligibility and reimbursement rate of a school, group of schools, or school |
| 14 | district for the community eligibility provision; and |
| 15 | (c) "Paid rate" means the partial reimbursement rate a school participating in |
| 16 | the community eligibility provision receives for providing a no-charge |
| 17 | school breakfast or lunch that is not eligible for reimbursement at the free |
| 18 | rate through the community eligibility provision. |
| 19 | (2) The Kentucky Proud School Match Program is hereby established to reduce the |
| 20 | financial burden of eligible school districts participating in the community |
| 21 | eligibility provision. The Kentucky Department of Education shall reimburse an |
| 22 | eligible school district thirty-three cents (\$0.33) for each meal that is: |
| 23 | (a) Reimbursed by the United States Department of Agriculture through the |
| 24 | community eligibility provision at the paid rate; and |
| 25 | (b) Provided by a school participating in the community eligibility provision |
| 26 | that qualifies individually, as part of a group of schools, or as part of a |
| 27 | district with an identified student percentage of at least forty percent (40%). |

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| 1 | <u>(3)</u> | A school district with at least one (1) school or group of schools participating in |
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| 2 | | the community eligibility provision shall be eligible to participate in the Kentucky |
| 3 | | Proud School Match Program upon development and implementation of a |
| 4 | | Kentucky Proud school plan to: |
| 5 | | (a) Identify and purchase available Kentucky-grown agricultural products that |
| 6 | | meet the applicable quality standards and pricing requirements of the |
| 7 | | school district. The plan may prioritize the purchase of Kentucky Proud |
| 8 | | agricultural products; and |
| 9 | | (b) Optimize food usage in the district's school nutrition programs in order to |
| 10 | | reduce food waste in the district. Districts are encouraged to incorporate the |
| 11 | | use of a share table program in the Kentucky Proud school plan. |
| 12 | <u>(4)</u> | The Kentucky Board of Education shall promulgate administrative regulations in |
| 13 | | accordance with KRS Chapter 13A necessary to carry out this section, including |
| 14 | | an application form for the Kentucky Proud School Match Program, a sample |
| 15 | | Kentucky Proud school plan, and method of data collection to measure the |
| 16 | | impact of the Kentucky Proud School Match Program. |
| 17 | <u>(5)</u> | In the event that the United States Department of Agriculture terminates the |
| 18 | | community eligibility provision, the provisions of this section shall be considered |
| 19 | | null and void. |
| 20 | | Section 2. This Act may be cited as the Kentucky Proud School Match Act. |
