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1	AN ACT relating to smoke alarms.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 227 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, all existing single-family dwellings,
6	two (2) family dwellings, and multifamily residential units shall have at least one
7	(1) working smoke detector inside each dwelling or unit, or shall have a new
8	hardwired or ten (10) year lithium smoke detector installed in each dwelling or
9	unit prior to the sale, lease, change of ownership, or change in tenancy of the
10	dwelling or unit.
11	(2) It shall be the responsibility of the property owner or seller to test and provide
12	working smoke detectors in the dwelling or unit. The seller shall attest to the
13	presence and functioning of the required smoke detector by providing a signed
14	affidavit to the purchaser at the real estate closing prior to the transfer of the
15	property.
16	(3) An individual licensed under KRS Chapter 324 shall not be liable for the actions
17	or inactions of a property owner or seller under this section.
