The internal auditor shall 12 report directly to the trustees of the Kentucky Public Pensions Authority to 13 perform internal audit functions as directed by the Authority. The executive 14 director and internal auditor shall work cooperatively with the chief executive 15 officers of the Kentucky Retirement Systems and the County Employees 16 Retirement System.
