1 AN ACT relating to technology in public schools. 2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky: 3 → Section 1. KRS 158.165 is amended to read as follows: 4 (1) The board of education of each school district shall adopt[develop] a policy 5 regarding the possession and use of a personal telecommunications device by a 6 student while on school property or while attending a school-sponsored or school-7 related activity on or off school property, and shall include the policy in the 8 district's written standards of student conduct. The policy shall, at a minimum, 9 forbid a student's use of a personal telecommunications device during 10 instructional time, except during an emergency or if directed to do so by a teacher 11 for an instructional purpose. A student who violates the policy shall be subject to 12 discipline as provided by board policy. 13 As used in this section, "personal telecommunications device": 14 (a) Means a device that emits an audible signal, vibrates, displays a message, or 15 otherwise summons or delivers a communication to the possessor, including [,] 16 but not limited to [,] a paging device and a cellular telephone; and Shall not include any device a student is authorized to use pursuant to the 17 18 Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, 20 U.S.C. sec. 1400 et seq., the 19 Americans with Disabilities Act, 42 U.S.C. sec. 12101 et seq., or the

Rehabilitation Act of 1973, 29 U.S.C. sec. 701 et seg., or successor acts.
