15			grade equivalency examination held under regulations adopted by the		
16			Kentucky Board of Education has been filed with the nominating petition		
17			required by KRS 118.315; and		
18		(e)	For a candidate who files a nominating petition as required by KRS 118.315		
19			on or after January 1, 2025[April 4, 2018], unless a high school or		
20			<i>postsecondary</i> transcript evidencing completion of the twelfth grade or results		
21			of a twelfth grade equivalency examination has been filed with the		
22			nominating petition. If no transcript is available, the candidate may submit a		
23			sworn affidavit that the candidate has completed the twelfth grade or the		
24			<u>international equivalent;</u> or		
25		(f)	Who holds any elective federal, state, county, or city office; or		
26		(g)	Who, at the time of his <i>or her</i> election, is directly or indirectly interested in		
27			the sale to the board of books, stationery, or any other property, materials,

- (h) Who has been removed from membership on a board of education for cause;
 or
- 4 (i) Who has a relative as defined in subsection (1) of this section employed by
 5 the school district and is elected after July 13, 1990. However, this shall not
 6 apply to a board member holding office on July 13, 1990, whose relative was
 7 not initially hired by the district during the tenure of the board member.
- 8 (3)If, after the election of any member of the board, he or she becomes interested in 9 any contract with or claims against the board, of the kind mentioned in paragraph 10 (g) of subsection (2) of this section, or if he <u>or she</u> moves his <u>or her</u> residence from 11 the district for which he <u>or she</u> was chosen, or if he <u>or she</u> attempts to influence the 12 hiring of any school employee, except the superintendent of schools or school board 13 attorney, or if he <u>or she</u> does anything that would render him <u>or her</u> ineligible for 14 reelection, he or she shall be subject to removal from office pursuant to KRS 15 415.050 and 415.060.
- 16 (4) A board member shall be eligible for reelection unless he <u>or she</u> becomes
 17 disqualified.
- 18 (5) The annual in-service training requirements for all school board members in office19 as of December 31, 2014, shall be as follows:
- 20 (a) Twelve (12) hours for school board members with zero to three (3) years of
 21 experience;
- (b) Eight (8) hours for school board members with four (4) to seven (7) years of
 experience; and
- 24 (c) Four (4) hours for school board members with eight (8) or more years of
 25 experience.
- 26 The Kentucky Board of Education shall identify the criteria for fulfilling this27 requirement.

1 (6) $\frac{(a)}{(a)}$ For all board members who begin their initial service on or after January 1, 2 2015, the annual in-service training requirements shall be: 3 Twelve (12) hours for school board members with zero to eight (8) years of *(a)* 4 experience, including a minimum of one (1) hour of ethics training; and 5 Eight (8) hours for school board members with more than eight (8) years of **(b)** 6 experience, including a minimum of one (1) hour of ethics training. 7 [(b) Training topics for school board members shall include: 8 1. Three (3) hours of finance, one (1) hour of ethics, and one (1) hour of 9 superintendent evaluation annually for members with zero to three (3) years' 10 experience; 11 2. Two (2) hours of finance, one (1) hour of ethics, and one (1) hour of superintendent 12 evaluation annually for members with four (4) to seven (7) years' experience; and 13 One (1) hour of finance, one (1) hour of ethics, and one (1) hour of superintendent 3. 14 evaluation biennially for members with eight (8) or more years' experience.] 15 The Kentucky Board of Education shall identify criteria for fulfilling this 16 requirement.
