

1 AN ACT relating to cosmetology.

2 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

3 ➔Section 1. KRS 317A.130 is amended to read as follows:

- 4 (1) No instructor, student, cosmetologist, or nail technician shall:
- 5 (a) Fail to provide the head rest of each chair with a relaundersed towel or a sheet
6 of clean paper for each person;
- 7 (b) Fail to place around the patron's neck a strip of cotton, towel, or neck strip so
8 that the haircloth does not come in contact with the patron's skin;
- 9 (c) Use on one (1) patron a towel that has been used upon another patron, unless
10 the towel has been relaundersed;
- 11 (d) Use on any patron any razor, scissors, tweezers, comb, bowl, recirculating
12 pipes, rubber disc, or part of vibrator or other similar equipment or appliance
13 that comes into contact with the head, face, hands, feet, or neck of a patron,
14 until the equipment or appliance has been sterilized in accordance with
15 methods of sterilization that are bacteriologically effective and approved by
16 the Cabinet for Health and Family Services; or
- 17 (e) Use on any patron a liquid nail enhancement product containing monomeric
18 methyl methacrylate, also known as dental acrylic monomer, for the purpose
19 of creating artificial nail enhancements in the practice of cosmetology and nail
20 technology.
- 21 (2) No esthetician practicing under this chapter shall perform any of the following
22 unless practicing under the immediate supervision of a licensed physician:
- 23 (a) Botox or collagen injections;
- 24 (b) Laser treatments;
- 25 (c) Electrolysis;
- 26 (d) Tattoo;
- 27 (e) Permanent makeup;

1 (f) Microblading; or

2 (g) Piercing.

3 **(3) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit an instructor, student,**
4 **cosmetologist, or nail technician from using callus graters for callus removal,**
5 **and the Board of Cosmetology shall not promulgate regulations prohibiting the**
6 **use of callus graters for callus removal.**
