1	AN ACT relating to Purple Star Schools.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 160 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) As used in this section:
6	(a) "Military-connected student" means a child enrolled in a Kentucky public
7	school who is a dependent of a current or former member of the Armed
8	Forces of the United States, the Kentucky National Guard, or any reserve
9	component thereof; and
10	(b) "Purple star school" means any public, private, or public charter school
11	serving any grades of kindergarten through twelfth grade that has
12	committed to supporting the educational and social-emotional needs of
13	military-connected students, as identified by the Kentucky Commission on
14	<u>Military Affairs.</u>
15	(2) The Kentucky Commission on Military Affairs shall establish the Purple Star
16	School Program and establish an application, review, and designation process for
17	eligible schools.
18	(3) To qualify as a purple star school, the school shall:
19	(a) Designate a staff member as a military liaison to serve as the point of
20	contact between the school and military-connected students and their
21	families, whose duties shall include:
22	<b><u>1.</u></b> Identifying military-connected students enrolled in the school;
23	2. Determining appropriate services available to military-connected
24	<u>students;</u>
25	3. Coordinating programs relevant to military-connected students;
26	4. Assisting military-connected students in transitioning into or out of
27	the school;

1	5. Facilitating optional professional development for staff members on
2	issues related to military-connected students;
3	6. Completing a Kentucky Commission on Military Affairs purple star
4	school questionnaire to provide feedback for program improvements;
5	and
6	7. Completing Kentucky purple star school self-paced online training
7	events, including military youth in Kentucky;
8	(b) Maintain a web page on the school's website that includes a prominent
9	display of the Kentucky purple star logo provided by the Kentucky
10	Commission on Military Affairs, resources for military-connected students
11	and their families, and information regarding:
12	1. Relocation, enrollment, registration, and transferring records in the
13	<u>school;</u>
14	2. Academic planning, course sequences, and advanced classes
15	available;
16	3. Counseling and other support services available for military-
17	connected students enrolled in the school; and
18	4. Contact information for the military liaison designated in this
19	subsection;
20	(c) Host at least one (1) military recognition event annually that connects the
21	school with the military community; and
22	(d) Submit an application for designation as a purple star school with the
23	Kentucky Commission on Military Affairs.
