1 AN ACT relating to school boards and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

- 3 → Section 1. KRS 160.280 is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (1) Members of boards of education shall receive no salaries, but members of boards of
- 5 education may receive, for each day a regular or special meeting is attended, a per
- 6 diem of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150) and their actual expenses. Members shall
- 7 receive this same per diem for training required by KRS 160.180. In no case shall
- 8 the expenses incurred within the district or per diem of any member exceed
- 9 <u>eight[six]</u> thousand dollars (\$8,000[\$6,000]) in any calendar year.
- 10 (2) Members of boards of education may be reimbursed for actual and necessary
- expenditures incurred outside the district in the performance of their duties
- 12 authorized by the board.

- 13 (3) All claims shall be made out according to law and filed with the secretary of the
- board and shall be approved and paid as other claims against the board.
- 15 (4) Board members shall be eligible to participate in any group medical or dental
- insurance plan provided to employees of the district pursuant to KRS 161.158.
- Participating board members shall pay the full cost of any premium required for
- their participation in the plan.
- → Section 2. Whereas it is necessary to ensure that members of local boards are
- 20 adequately reimbursed for expenses incurred in the performance of their duties, an
- 21 emergency is declared and this Act takes effect July 1, 2024.
