- regulations, policies, budgets, and treatment and service standards which may facilitate strategies for prevention and reduce the number of child and maternal fatalities.
- 7 (4) The state child and maternal fatality team established pursuant to subsection (2) 8 of this section shall review and analyze all child fatalities or near fatalities in the 9 Commonwealth each year that involve a person under the age of eighteen (18) 10 years who had a gunshot wound. The results of this review and analysis shall be 11 a part of the annual report required by subsection (5) of this section.
- The department shall prepare an annual report to be submitted no later than *(5)* November 1 of each year to the Governor, the Interim Joint Committee on Families and Children, the Chief Justice of the *Commonwealth*[Kentucky Supreme Court], and to be made available to the citizens of the Commonwealth. The report shall 16 include a statistical analysis, that includes the demographics of race, income, and geography, of the incidence and causes of child and maternal fatalities in the Commonwealth during the past fiscal year and recommendations for action. The report shall not include any information which would identify specific child and 20 maternal fatality cases.

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
