AN ACT relating to professional development.
Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
$\rightarrow$ SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 156 IS CREATED TO
READ AS FOLLOWS:
(1) The Kentucky Department of Education may enter into an agreement with a
building and construction trade organization to develop a training program for
school counselors providing services to students in the Commonwealth. The
purpose of the training program shall be to promote building and construction
trades and training facilities available to students by making school counselors
aware of what is available to students participating in the building and
construction trade. The training program shall include information relating to:
(a) The pay and benefits available to people who work in the building and
construction trades; and
Job opportunities and available apprenticeships for boilermakers, electrical
(b) workers, bricklayers, insulators, laborers, iron workers, plumbers and
(b) pipefitters, roofers, plasterers and cement masons, sheet metal workers,
thepartment shall include the training program created in this section on the
requested by the training program.
(4) A school counselor serving students in grades seven (7) through twelve (12) may complete four (4) hours of training developed under this section which shall count towards the twenty-one (21) hours required annually pursuant to KRS 156.101(4)(b)2.
(5) Local boards of education or school-based decision making councils may incorporate this training as part of the four (4) days of professional development required pursuant to KRS 158.070(3)(a) for teachers who serve students in grades seven (7) through twelve (12) if offered by the participating trade organization.
