5		qualified service providers necessary to carry out the pr	rovisions of KRS 200.650 to	
6		200.676 are appropriately and adequately prepared and trained in order to comply		
7		with the requirements of federal law and regulations.		
8	(2)	The cabinet shall provide the components of a comprehensive system of personnel		
9		development which shall include:		
10		(a) Preservice and inservice training conducted on an	interdisciplinary basis to the	
11		extent appropriate; and		
12		(b) Training provided for a variety of entities, including	ing but not limited to, public	
13		and private providers, primary referral sources, pa	rents, paraprofessionals, and	
14		persons who serve as professional service coordin	ators or case managers.	
15	(3)	Training may include:		
16		(a) Implementing innovative strategies and activiti	es for the recruitment and	
17		retention of early intervention service providers;		
18		(b) Promoting the preparation of early intervention	providers who are fully and	
19		appropriately qualified to provide early intervention	on;	
20		(c) Training personnel to work in rural areas; and		
21		(d) Recruiting and training personnel to coordinate to	ransition services for infants	
22		and toddlers with disabilities from an early	intervention program to a	
23		preschool program.		
24	(4)	The cabinet shall coordinate with other agencies, inclu	uding but not limited to the
