

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicle license plates.

2 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

3 ➔Section 1. KRS 186.174 is amended to read as follows:

- 4 (1) For purposes of this section, "personalized license plate" means a license plate
5 manufactured by the cabinet upon an applicant's request with specific letters or
6 numbers or combinations of letters and numbers significant to the applicant.
- 7 (2) Any owner or lessee of a motor vehicle ***or recreational vehicle*** that is required to
8 be registered under the provisions of KRS 186.050(1), (3)(a), ~~for~~(4)(a), or ***(11), or***
9 any owner or lessee of a motorcycle required to be registered under the provisions
10 of KRS 186.050(2) may obtain a personalized license plate by submitting an
11 application through a Web site designated by the cabinet. The cabinet shall produce
12 the requested license plate upon approval and receipt of the fee required in
13 subsection (4) of this section for a special license plate, or the fee required in KRS
14 186.162 for a standard issue license plate.
- 15 (3) Personalized license plates shall expire on the last day of the birth month of the
16 person to whom the license plate is registered.
- 17 (4) (a) A personalized license plate shall be replaced on the same schedule as regular
18 issue license plates unless it is damaged or unreadable.
- 19 (b) A standard issued license plate may be personalized for a forty-three dollar
20 (\$43) fee as provided in KRS 186.162(2)(m), in addition to all other fees
21 established in this section and in KRS 186.050.
- 22 (c) Any special license plate may be combined with a personalized license plate
23 for a twenty-five dollar (\$25) state fee in addition to all other fees for the
24 particular special license plate established in this section and in KRS 186.164.
25 The twenty-five dollar (\$25) fee required under this paragraph shall be
26 divided between the cabinet and the county clerk of the county where the
27 applicant resides with the cabinet receiving twenty dollars (\$20) and the

1 county clerk receiving five dollars (\$5).

2 (5) (a) A personalized plate shall not be issued that would conflict with or duplicate
3 any current issued license plate.

4 (b) A personalized plate shall not be issued if the cabinet determines:

5 1. The message to be placed on the license plate, if created, discriminates
6 against a race, color, religion, sex, or national origin;

7 2. The plate message is the name of a trademarked or copyrighted product
8 or brand name; or

9 3. The plate's lettering or message is obscene or profane, as determined by
10 the cabinet.

11 (c) Once an applicant obtains a personalized plate, he or she will have first
12 priority on that plate for each of the following years that he or she makes
13 timely renewal payments.

14 ➔Section 2. KRS 186.162 (Effective January 1, 2024) is amended to read as
15 follows:

16 (1) As used in this section and in KRS 186.043, 186.164, 186.166, 186.1722, and
17 186.174:

18 (a) "Special license plate" means a unique license plate issued under this chapter
19 to a group or organization that readily identifies the operator of the motor
20 vehicle or motorcycle bearing the plate as a member of a group or
21 organization, or a supporter of the work, goals, or mission of a group or
22 organization. The term shall not include regular license plates issued under
23 KRS 186.240;

24 (b) "Street rod" means a modernized private passenger motor vehicle
25 manufactured prior to the year 1949, or designed or manufactured to resemble
26 a vehicle manufactured prior to 1949;

27 (c) "SF" means the portion of an initial or renewal fee to obtain a special license

1 plate that is dedicated for use by the Transportation Cabinet;

2 (d) "CF" means the county clerk's fee for issuing a motor vehicle registration as
3 established under KRS 186.040(1). If a CF amount is charged for a license
4 plate listed in this section, the applicant for that plate shall also pay the fees
5 identified in KRS 186.040(6). If a CF amount is not charged, the applicant
6 shall not be required to pay those fees; and

7 (e) "EF" means the portion of an initial or renewal fee to obtain a special license
8 plate that is mandated by this chapter to be dedicated for use by a particular
9 group or organization.

10 (2) The initial purchase fee and renewal fee for a special license plate created under this
11 chapter shall be as established in this subsection and includes the name of group or
12 organization and the total initial and renewal fee required for the plate. The amount
13 in parentheses indicates how the total fee is required to be divided:

14 (a) Disabled veterans who receive assistance to purchase a vehicle from the
15 United States Department of Veterans' Affairs, veterans declared by the
16 United States Department of Veterans' Affairs to be one hundred percent
17 (100%) service-connected disabled, and recipients of the Congressional
18 Medal of Honor:

19 1. Initial Fee: \$0 (\$0 SF/\$0 CF/\$0 EF).

20 2. Renewal Fee: \$0 (\$0 SF/\$0 CF/\$0 EF).

21 (b) Former prisoners of war and survivors of Pearl Harbor:

22 1. Initial Fee: \$23 (\$12 SF/\$6 CF/\$5 EF to the veterans'
23 program trust fund established under KRS 40.460).

24 2. Renewal Fee: ~~\$11~~ ~~[\$6]~~ (\$0 SF/\$6 CF/~~\$5~~ ~~[\$0]~~ EF to the
25 veterans' program trust fund established under KRS 40.460).

26 (c) Members of the Kentucky National Guard and recipients of the Purple Heart:

27 1. Initial Fee: \$23 (\$12 SF/\$6 CF/\$5 EF to the veterans'

- 2 2. Renewal Fee: \$11 (\$0 SF/\$6 CF/\$5 EF to the veterans'
- 3 program trust fund established under KRS 40.460).
- 4 (d) Members of the Civil Air Patrol; active, retired, veteran, reserve, or auxiliary
- 5 members of the United States Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, or Coast
- 6 Guard; Merchant Marines who served between December 7, 1941, and
- 7 August 15, 1945; recipients of the Silver Star Medal, the Distinguished Flying
- 8 Cross, the Air Medal, the Combat Action Badge, the Combat Infantry Badge,
- 9 or the Bronze Star Medal; persons who wish to receive Gold Star Mothers,
- 10 Gold Star Fathers, or Gold Star Spouses license plates beyond the two (2)
- 11 exempted from fees under KRS 186.041(6); individuals eligible for a special
- 12 military service academy license plate under KRS 186.041(8); individuals
- 13 eligible for a special military unit license plate under KRS 186.163; and
- 14 disabled veterans who have been declared to be between fifty percent (50%)
- 15 and ninety-nine percent (99%) service-connected disabled by the United
- 16 States Department of Veterans' Affairs:

- 2 1. Initial Fee for two plates: \$56 (\$50 SF/\$6 CF/\$0 EF).
- 3 2. Renewal Fee: Do not renew annually.

7 plate).

8 (u) Independent Colleges:

9 1. Initial Fee: \$41 (\$25 SF/\$6 CF/\$10 EF to the Association of
10 Independent Kentucky Colleges and Universities for distribution to the
11 general scholarship funds of the Association's members).

12 2. Renewal Fee: \$28 (\$12 SF/\$6 CF/\$10 EF to the Association of
13 Independent Kentucky Colleges and Universities for distribution to the
14 general scholarship funds of the Association's members).

15 (v) Child Victims:

16 1. Initial Fee: \$41 (\$25 SF/\$6 CF/\$10 EF to the child victims'
17 trust fund established under KRS 41.400).

18 2. Renewal Fee: ~~\$28~~[\$23] (\$12 SF/\$6 CF/~~\$10~~[\$5] EF to the
19 child victims' trust fund established under KRS 41.400).

20 (w) Kentucky Horse Council:

- 3 (y) Spay neuter:

5 and care fund established under KRS 258.119).
- 6 2. Renewal Fee: ~~\$28~~~~[\$23]~~ (\$12 SF/\$6 CF/~~\$10~~~~[\$5]~~ EF to the
7 animal control and care fund established under KRS 258.119).
- 8 (z) Gold Star Mothers, Gold Star Fathers, or Gold Star Spouses:
- 9 1. Initial Fee: \$0 (\$0 SF/\$0 CF/ \$0 EF).
- 10 2. Renewal Fee: \$0 (\$0 SF/\$0 CF/ \$0 EF).
- 11 3. A person may receive a maximum of two (2) plates under this paragraph
12 free of charge and may purchase additional plates for fees as established
13 in subsection (2)(d) of this section.
- 14 (aa) I Support Veterans:

2 (ad) Personalized plates for a recreational vehicle that is required to be
3 registered under the provisions of KRS 186.050(11):

4 1. Initial Fee: \$51 (\$45 SF/\$6 CF/\$0 EF).

5 2. Renewal Fee: \$51 (\$45 SF/\$6 CF/\$0 EF).

6 (ae) Special license plates established under KRS 186.164:

7 1. Initial Fee: \$41 (\$25 SF/\$6 CF/\$10 EF).

8 2. Renewal Fee: \$41 (\$25 SF/\$6 CF/\$10 EF).

9 (3) Any special license plate may be combined with a personalized license plate for a
10 twenty-five dollar (\$25) state fee in addition to all other fees for the particular
11 special license plate established in this section and in KRS 186.164(3). The twenty-
12 five dollar (\$25) fee required under this subsection shall be divided between the
13 cabinet and the county clerk of the county where the applicant is applying for the
14 license plate with the cabinet receiving twenty dollars (\$20) and the county clerk
15 receiving five dollars (\$5).

16 (4) (a) A sponsoring organization of any special license plate issued under this
17 section or any special license plate established under the provisions of KRS
18 186.164 may petition the cabinet for the production of that special license
19 plate for motorcycles.

20 (b) The cabinet shall make all of the special military license plates in this section
21 available for motorcycles owned or leased by eligible individuals.

22 (c) Owners and lessees of motorcycles registered under KRS 186.050(2) may be
23 eligible to receive special license plates approved by the cabinet under
24 paragraphs (a) and (b) of this subsection. Applicants for a special license plate
25 for a motorcycle shall be required to pay the fee for a special plate as
26 prescribed in this section or in KRS 186.164. The fee paid for the special plate
27 for a motorcycle shall be in lieu of the registration fee required under KRS

1 186.050(2).
