A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION establishing the Teacher Red Tape Reduction
 Task Force.

WHEREAS, unfilled teacher positions in Kentucky have increased by 260% percent since 2019 according to the staff of the Legislative Research Commission's Office of Education Accountability, which means it is more important than ever that Kentucky take competitive steps to protect the teaching profession; and

WHEREAS, excessive mandates impose an undue burden on Kentucky teachers
that harms the dignity of the teaching profession and the ability of this Commonwealth to
attract and maintain high quality teachers; and

10 WHEREAS, reducing the amount of time Kentucky teachers spend on compliance 11 and administrative tasks will grant teachers the freedom to focus on the activities that 12 have the greatest impact on student growth and achievement; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly seeks to reprioritize teaching, learning, and
 student outcomes over compliance and administrative tasks; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly is committed to collecting, analyzing, and leveraging data to inform deliberate and effective legislation to identify and eradicate outdated, redundant, or unnecessary mandates imposed upon teachers;

18 NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the
Commonwealth of Kentucky, the Senate concurring therein:

21 → Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission shall establish the Teacher
 22 Red Tape Reduction Task Force. The task force shall study and make recommendations
 23 to identify outdated, redundant, or unnecessary mandates imposed upon teachers.

24 → Section 2. The Teacher Red Tape Reduction Task Force. shall be composed of
25 the following members, with final membership being subject to the consideration and
26 approval of the Legislative Research Commission:

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(1) Four members of the House of Representatives, including three members to

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be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and one member appointed
by the Minority Floor Leader of the House of Representatives. One of the four members
of the House of Representatives shall be designated by the Speaker of the House to serve
as co-chair; and

5 (2) Four members of the Senate, including three members to be appointed by the 6 President of the Senate and one member to be appointed by the Minority Floor Leader of 7 the Senate. One of the four members of the Senate shall be designated by the President of 8 the Senate to serve as co-chair.

9 → Section 3. The task force shall meet as necessary during the 2024 Interim of the
10 General Assembly. The task force shall submit findings and recommendations to the
11 Legislative Research Commission for referral to the appropriate committee or committees
12 by December 1, 2024.

Section 4. Provisions of this Resolution to the contrary notwithstanding, the
Legislative Research Commission shall have the authority to alternatively assign the
issues identified herein to an interim joint committee or subcommittee thereof, and to
designate a study completion date.
