7	efforts to replant trees to make up for the trees that have been removed from their
8	community and throughout the Commonwealth; and
9	WHEREAS, trees provide many benefits to everyone in the Commonwealth,
10	including reducing stress, improving children's education, and providing emotional
11	support as memorials and commemorative symbols; and
12	WHEREAS, communities benefit from trees by reducing noise from busy
13	highways, complementing and beautifying architectural designs, and improving traffic
14	and roadway designs; and
15	WHEREAS, planting trees offers many environmental benefits, such as reducing
16	urban heat, improving the quality of air, and reducing storm water runoff, which reduces
17	erosion and pollution; and
18	WHEREAS, trees provide many economic benefits, including reducing cooling
19	costs for homes in warm months, reducing heating costs by protecting homes with
20	windbreak in the winter months, and decreasing demand on utility infrastructure, which
21	may reduce operating costs for utility companies; and
22	WHEREAS, under the leadership of Dr. Mike Key, the Lloyd Memorial High
23	School Leadership Around the World class brought the issue of reforestation to the
24	attention of the General Assembly; and
