9	focusing on the four pillars for student success, which includes integrated student
10	supports, expanded learning time and opportunities, active family and community
11	engagement, and collaborative leadership and practices for high quality teaching; and
12	WHEREAS, community schools serve as hubs for collaboration among educators,
13	families, local organizations, and government agencies to create a supportive
14	environment for students to thrive academically, socially, and emotionally; and
15	WHEREAS, the alignment of Kentucky's Family Resource and Youth Services
16	Centers and community school implementation fosters community engagement as equal
17	partners within the school system to ensure a support system to decrease and remove
18	nonacademic barriers so that schools can focus on high quality teaching and learning; and
19	WHEREAS, community schools promote equity and inclusivity by addressing the
20	unique challenges and barriers faced by students from underserved and marginalized
21	communities, thereby narrowing the opportunity gap; and
22	WHEREAS, research indicates that community schools contribute to higher
23	graduation rates, improved student attendance, increased parental involvement, and
24	enhanced academic achievement across diverse student populations; and
25	WHEREAS, investing in community schools is a commitment to providing all
26	students with the resources and support they need to succeed academically and lead
27	fulfilling lives; and

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1	WHEREAS, evidence-based results demonstrate that community schools lead to
2	robust and positive academic outcomes that are integral to fostering sustained economic
3	growth for individual students and their families well into adulthood for increased
4	economic well-being; and

6	positive correlative economic growth for our state and increased competitiveness on a
7	national and global scale;
