1	A RESOLUTION urging the United States Congress to amend Title II of the Social
2	Security Act to repeal the government pension offset and the windfall elimination
3	provision.
4	WHEREAS, the Social Security Act includes two provisions, the government
5	pension offset and the windfall elimination provision, that reduce Social Security benefits
6	payable to persons who are entitled to benefits from noncovered retirement systems under
7	certain conditions; and
8	WHEREAS, the government pension offset reduces public employees' Social
9	Security spousal or survival benefits by up to two-thirds of their public pension; and
10	WHEREAS, the windfall elimination provision reduces the earned Social Security
11	benefits of an individual who also receives a public pension from a position not covered
12	by Social Security; and
13	WHEREAS, the government pension offset and the windfall elimination provision
14	have inequitable effects on many teachers, firefighters, police officers, postal workers,
15	and others who have struggled their entire working careers to supplement family budgets
16	and retirement savings with part-time and summer jobs in which they paid into Social
17	Security; and
18	WHEREAS, the Congressional Research Service released data in December 2021
19	showing the government pension offset disproportionately affects women, who accounted
20	for 83 percent of all persons affected; and
21	WHEREAS, as of December 2022, almost 81 percent of Kentuckians affected by
22	the government pension offset lose their entire spousal benefit, even though their spouses
23	paid Social Security taxes for many years; and
24	WHEREAS, the government pension offset and the windfall elimination provision
25	impact the teaching profession, as individuals who worked in other careers are less likely
26	to desire to become educators if doing so will result in the loss of earned Social Security
27	benefits; and

1	WHEREAS, the government pension offset has the severest effect on widowed
2	lower-income women who have worked for years and can least afford reduced benefits;
3	and
4	WHEREAS, the amounts lost due to the government pension offset and the
5	windfall elimination provision can make the difference between self-sufficiency and
6	poverty; and
7	WHEREAS, Kentucky is one of the 20 states most impacted by the government
8	pension offset and the windfall elimination provision; and
9	WHEREAS, bipartisan legislation concerning the repeal of the government pension
10	offset and the windfall elimination provision was introduced in the 118th Congress;
11	NOW, THEREFORE,
12	Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the
13	Commonwealth of Kentucky:
14	→ Section 1. This honorable body respectfully urges the United States Congress to
15	amend Title II of the Social Security Act to repeal the government pension offset and the
16	windfall elimination provision.
17	→ Section 2. The Clerk of the House of Representatives is directed to transmit a
18	copy of this Resolution to the President of the United States and the members of the
19	Kentucky Congressional Delegation.
