

1 A RESOLUTION honoring the hard work of Kentucky teachers.

2 WHEREAS, the future of the Commonwealth of Kentucky depends upon providing
3 quality education to all students; and

4 WHEREAS, teachers across the Commonwealth carry out a major responsibility in
5 preparing our young people to assume their roles as effective citizens; and

6 WHEREAS, the success of our children and communities are considerably
7 influenced by exemplary teachers who devote their hearts and minds to helping our
8 public schools and youth excel; and

9 WHEREAS, the teaching profession should be afforded high public esteem, and
10 reflect a community's value on public education; and

11 WHEREAS, teachers spend countless hours preparing lessons, evaluating progress,
12 counseling, and coaching students all while acting as role models, motivators, and
13 mentors for students throughout the Commonwealth; and

14 WHEREAS, the General Assembly recognizes the hard work of the more than
15 40,000 teachers across the Commonwealth who serve more than 638,000 students in the
16 state; and

17 WHEREAS, teachers are challenged daily to reach all students regardless of ability,
18 interest, social or economic background, handicap, race, religion, creed, or ethnic origin
19 to provide the instruction, assistance, and guidance necessary for full development; and

20 WHEREAS, teachers are fully committed to the success and continued advocacy of
21 Kentucky students; and

22 WHEREAS, teachers across the Commonwealth continue to shape the future of the
23 next generation of Kentuckians; and

24 WHEREAS, the General Assembly recognizes and supports its teachers in
25 educating students across the Commonwealth;
