| 7  | WHEREAS, the Kentucky Department for Medicaid Services currently operates                   |
| 8  | three 1915(c) Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) waivers for individuals              |
| 9  | with intellectual and developmental disabilities; and                                       |
| 0  | WHEREAS, more than 20,000 residents of the Commonwealth are enrolled in these               |
| 1  | waiver programs; and  |
| 2  | WHEREAS, an additional 10,000 Kentuckians are currently on waiting lists for                |
| 13 | enrollment in 1915(c) HCBS waiver programs; and   |
| 4  | WHEREAS, the Kentucky General Assembly has taken steps to increase                          |
| 15 | reimbursement rates to help mitigate the staffing shortage that contributes to the waiver   |
| 6  | waitlist; and   |
| 17 | WHEREAS, Kentucky's community-based HCBS waiver service providers have                      |
| 8  | struggled for years to recruit and retain qualified direct support professionals (DSP) and  |
| 9  | other critical staff to provide services to individuals with intellectual and developmental |
| 20 | disabilities; and   |
| 21 | WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic had a significant impact on Kentucky's                       |
| 22 | system of community-based care providers by depleting the state's DSP workforce; and        |
| 23 | WHEREAS, more than 40 percent of Kentucky's 120 counties border another state;              |
| 24 | and   |
| 25 | WHEREAS, many residents in Kentucky's border counties regularly receive                     |
| 26 | healthcare services in bordering states; and  |
| 27 | WHEREAS, current federal regulations prohibit Medicaid beneficiaries, in nearly             |

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1 all instances, including those enrolled in a 1915(c) HCBS waiver program, from

- 2 receiving care outside of their home state except in emergency situations; and
- WHEREAS, Medicaid beneficiaries are denied access to care in bordering states;
- 4 NOW, THEREFORE,
- 5 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the
- 6 Commonwealth of Kentucky:
- 7 → Section 1. This honorable body respectfully urges the Kentucky Department for
- 8 Medicaid Services to initiate communication with the Commonwealth's neighboring
- 9 states regarding the possibility of establishing and entering into an interstate compact
- with the Commonwealth of Kentucky to permit 1915(c) Home and Community-Based
- 11 Medicaid waiver services beneficiaries to receive covered waiver services in any of the
- 12 compact states.
