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- AN ACT relating to the diagnosis of sepsis. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky: →SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 205 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS: <u>To encourage the early identification and treatment of sepsis and for consistency with</u> <u>the ICD-10 coding classification system utilized by the federal Centers for Medicare</u> <u>and Medicaid Services, the Department for Medicaid Services and any managed care</u> <u>organization with which the department contracts for the delivery of Medicaid services</u> <u>shall use and apply clinical criteria for sepsis that requires no more than:</u>
- 10 (1) A provider's diagnosis of sepsis and that a suspected or confirmed source of
- 11 *infection is present; and*
- 12 (2) The presence of two (2) or more symptoms indicating inflammatory response
- 13 syndrome which may include elevated values of the patient's body temperature,
- 14 *heart rate, white blood count, or respiratory rate.*
